The ACCELL program at Annie Purl is made up of literacy and math instruction, provided in a small group setting. Reading Recovery, a program for first grade students, is also part of the ACCELL program.

Common questions about the ACCELL program:

Q: How is the program funded?

A: Annie Purl qualifies to receive federal Title I funds. These funds provide for additional instructors in reading, writing and math.

Q: What does Title I mean?

A: The term "Title I" means that the funding comes from the federal government, and there are many "restrictions" or "titles" to the funds.

Q: How is the amount of funding calculated?

A: Purl receives money based on the number of students in our school who receive free or reduced lunch. Please note: economic level is NOT used to determine who will receive additional services at Annie Purl. Students who receive services are working below grade level according to district criteria.

ACCELL Math Guidelines

The ACCELL Math teacher supports pre-kindergarten, kindergarten, first and second grade teachers in the use of effective instructional strategies for those students not performing satisfactorily on the GISD Math Checkpoint Test and TEKS.

Co-Teaching, small group instruction, consulting, parent involvement and staff development is used to help students meet academic achievement standards expected of all children on the TEKS.

Q: When does ACCELL instruction happen?

A: The instruction happens during the school day. The classroom teacher and ACCELL teacher schedule times for the student that do not disrupt other learning in the classroom.
