As part of the state-mandated health curriculum, a unit on human sexuality is taught to all GISD middle school students and all students in high school Health classes. The teachers utilize Scott & White's abstinence-education curriculum entitled "Worth the Wait." The curriculum includes a comprehensive two-week unit based on the medical and legal facts regarding teen sexuality.

According to the Texas Education Code, GISD must provide you with the opportunity to review the content of the District's human sexuality instruction. Scott & White doctors and health educators, along with GISD registered nurses, will conduct a parent information meeting on Wednesday, November 4, 2009 at 6:30 p.m. at the GHS Annex Campus (located north of the High School) in the cafeteria 2295 N. Austin Ave. Georgetown, Texas.

All parents/guardians of middle school and high school Health students are encouraged to attend. Research shows that parents are the most influential persons regarding teens' decisions about sex. A curriculum review and tips for talking to teens about sex and other risk behaviors will be presented.

As a parent/guardian, you have the right to remove your child from any part of the human sexuality instruction. If you cannot attend the parent information night, but would like to preview the curriculum, please make an appointment with the campus school nurse before November 24, 2009. If you do not want your child to participate in this unit, please complete the attached form and return it to your child's school nurse by November 24, 2009.
