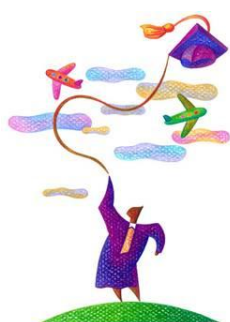

Student Pick-Up

Our procedure for Student Pick up will remain the same. The Kindergarten will be waiting closer to the building, First Grade in the middle and Second Grade closer to the playground. Please use your hangtag it helps our teachers with the identification of your vehicle so we can get your child ready to enter the car.

Dismissal is at 3:00 and scholars will exit the building in the following order: kinder first, 1st grade next then 2nd Grade. If your child needs to go home differently than normal, please contact the office with a



written note or phone call before 2:50 to insure that we get the message to the teacher. Please remember that we will not allow children to cross the parking lot alone, parents/guardians should

park in a parking space and walk to the teacher in charge in order to pickup a child. This is to ensure that all children stay physically safe and that all children go home with the proper adult. We are also asking that parents/guardians refrain from parking in the Fire Zone that is marked off by the cones. Safety first!

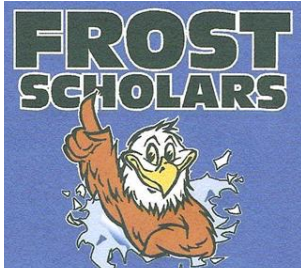
