One of the favorite duties as a Member of Congress is nominating Texas District 31's best and brightest young men and women to our nation's service academies. If you are a highly motivated, well-rounded, successful student, Congressman Carter invites you to consider the unique opportunity to develop physically, ethically, and intellectually while building a foundation for an exciting, challenging, and rewarding career as a military officer in the service of our nation. Texas District 31 area students traditionally are very successful at the academies, and the Congressman is pleased to do his part to ensure that the community continues to provide some of the next generation's outstanding military leaders. A congressional nomination is required for students wishing to enter the U.S. Military Academy, West Point, NY; the U.S. Naval Academy, Annapolis, MD; the U.S. Air Force Academy, Colorado Springs, CO; and the U.S. Merchant Marine Academy, Kings Point, NY. Successful applicants will have a broad academic background, the ability to pass a physical aptitude test, and strong leadership potential. An applicant must also be a U.S. citizen, a high school graduate between the ages of 17 and 23, unmarried, have no dependents, and be of high moral character. Acceptance of a service academy appointment requires at least a nine-year service obligation, including four years at an academy and five years of active duty service.

Any students interested in being considered for a service academy nomination, must contact Congressman Carter's Round Rock district office prior 10/30/2009 to be considered for the class entering the service academies in July, 2010.
