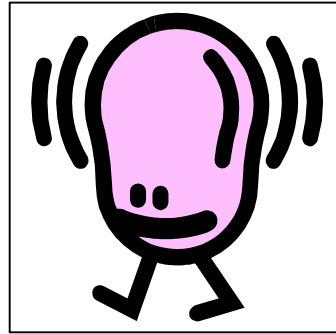
Spelling:
