Math:

We will begin Ch. 14 titled, Algebraic Thinking. Vocabulary words such as algebra, equation, dot, parentheses, square, and variable will be learned. Puzzles and "tricks" will be used to teach the students how to use their strategies to solve problems such as missing parts of puzzles and to find the value of x in number sentences.

Science:
