After researching information about your Native American tribe and the region they live in, choose one of the projects listed below.

1. Make a poster. Draw and explain (in your own words) each aspect of the tribe's daily life.
2. Make a salt map of Texas which shows the four geographical regions. Label each region and show the location of your tribe. Use note cards to explain each aspect of their daily life.
3. Create a model of the type of home used by your tribe. Include examples of their daily life in your model. Use note cards to explain each aspect of their daily life. NO PLASTIC INDIANS, PLEASE!

All projects must include the following information:

- ³ environment (region, forest, plains, desert, water source, etc.)
- ³ type of home (explain how the environment determines the type of home)
- ³ foods (grown, gathered, hunted, etc)
- ³ examples of daily life (clothing, recreation, weaving, jewelry, pottery)

Your research project must be about a Native American tribe in Texas. Some that we are studying about in class are the Karankawa, Coahuiltican, Caddo, Comanche, Tonkawa, Lipan Apache, Kiowa, Jumano, and Tigua.
