

Texas History Project 1820-1865

Choose one of the following activities. Be sure that your information is accurate and displayed in a neat and creative way.

- Identify at least 3 of the following people: Stephen F. Austin, William B. Travis, Sam Houston, Sanata Anna, Suzanna Dickinson, Mirabeau B. Lamar. Research biographical information about each and write about his/her contribution to Texas history. Possible ways to display this information might include: poster, mobile, journal, Bio Poem
- Make a time line of at least 5 important events in Texas history from 1820-1865. Illustrate and describe each event in detail. Possible ways to display this information might include: poster, movie box, etc.
- Make a salt map of Texas. Label the major battle sites from the Texas Revolution. Write a brief description of each battle on note cards.
- Write a dialogue for a skit covering one event in Texas history. You may choose several friends to act out your skit in front of the class.
- Design a flag that Texans might have used as a battle flag. Write about the meaning of your flag. You may not use a flag that really existed. Possible materials to use might include fabric, poster board, foam board, construction paper.
- Create a powerpoint presentation of the causes and effects of the Texas Revolution **or** create a powerpoint presentation describing three major battles of the Texas Revolution.
