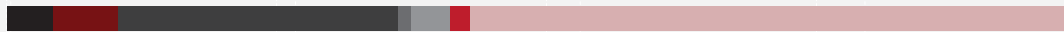

Destination Imagination is for grades 3-5 (competitive). In this program, students use a fun, hands on system of learning that will encourage creativity, problem solving, and team building.

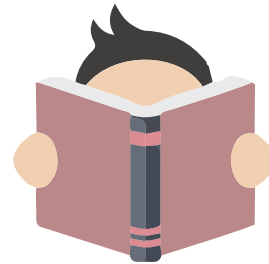
In the DI program, students must be able to work as a team. Adults are not allowed to "interfere" and must allow students to make all decisions in completing challenges for competition.



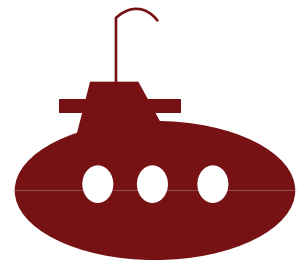
Georgetown ISD earned a "Met Standard," the highest rating from the Texas Education Agency's 2016 State District and Campus Accountability Ratings.
