



- Dual language programs are offered at Carver, Purl and Mitchell elementary schools. A 50/50 model delivers English and Spanish instruction to teach children a second language through content instruction and conversation.
- SeaPerch (underwater robotics) incorporates STEM curriculum to teach skills in ship and submarine design. More than 50 teams participate on 15 campuses.
- YMCA after-school care programs are offered at all elementary schools.
- Early education helps to build a foundation for lifelong learning. Full day pre-K is offered at <u>Carver</u>, <u>Mitchell</u>, <u>Purl</u> and <u>Pickett</u> for qualifying students.

- Wagner incorporates **Project Based Learning (PBL)** to support student attainment of the GISD Learner Profile. In PBL, learning of skills and content comes through students answering an open-ended question or solving a problem that could have many solutions that result in a product.
- As a **Raise Your Hand Texas**® pilot school, <u>Tippit</u> is personalizing instruction through a blended learning model to provide students increased opportunities for collaboration and connection to real-world problem-solving in math.
- Tippit hosts the district's **Kickstart Kids** program, where students learn character education through karate.
- Middle school students enjoy opportunities to participate in **UIL athletics** and **fine arts** programs, including orchestra.
- The After School Action Program (ASAP) is designed around student interests and may include coding, robotics, cooking, dance and yoga.

EAST VIEW HS

- GISD is committed to producing future-ready graduates. Approximately 60 career and technology education (CTE) courses are offered including aerospace engineering, veterinary science, accounting, biotechnology, culinary arts, law enforcement, agriculture, programming and design, audio/video production and automotive technology.
- More than **50 Dual Credit courses** allow students to earn college credit through Austin Community College. Additionally, GISD offers nearly 30 Advanced Placement (AP) classes.
- Robust **visual and performing arts** offerings include musical theater, show choir, marching band, color guard and orchestra.
- Athletic opportunities are extensive and include award-winning swim, soccer and wrestling programs.
- SeaPerch students compete annually in competition and have qualified for the national competition.
