

# SCHOOL SAFETY & SECURITY HIGHLIGHTS



## ACCESS CONTROL MEASURES

- Summer building safety audit (completed August 2022)
- Secure front-entries at every school
- Regularly scheduled exterior door checks at all campuses
- Standardized procedures for visitors to district campuses

## COMMUNICATION AND ALERT SYSTEMS

- 24/7 monitoring for potentially unsafe student communications on Gmail and Google Drive
- 24/7 anonymous threat reporting system
- See Something, Say Something student training in grades 6-12
- District-wide system for effective parent communication

## DRILLS AND CAMPUS TRAINING

- All staff (including subs) receive training on safety protocols, based on Standard Response Protocol & Avoid/Deny/Defend
- Campuses annually perform twice the required lockdown drills
- Campus administrators and school resource officers conduct after-action reviews of campus drills

## SAFE AND SUPPORTIVE SCHOOLS TEAMS

- Dedicated campus staff review threats to determine course of action and student supports needed.
- All team members, including campus administration and staff, school resource officers, and mental health providers are trained by the Texas School Safety Center.
