2020 RULES & GUIDELINES

No Entry Fee

- One previously unsubmitted and unpublished fiction entry per student
- May be portion of short story or larger work
- Final draft must be 2 – 10 pages only using following format instructions
- Entry should be double-spaced in 12-point, Times New Roman font, 1" margins all around
- Subject matter and language PG-13 or below
- Entries must be typed (no handwritten) with a cover sheet and completed registration form.
Number pages consecutively
- Only story name should appear on the pages of the manuscript
- Author's name, grade, school name, and email address should appear on cover sheet *ONLY*, not on the pages of the manuscript
- Authors retain ownership and all rights to their work
- Entries will be judged by SGWL authors
- Prizes awarded at sole discretion of judges; entries are not subject to review by the public
- First through third prizes + 2 honorable mentions will be awarded. Finalist's submissions will be published on the SGWL website
- Submit .doc or .docx file of submission electronically to: kearneyj@georgetownisd.org
- Include completed Registration Form with your submission
- Awards Ceremony April 2, 2020 at 6:15 p.m. for five finalists and families. Winners announced and prizes awarded then.
