On Tuesday, June 26<sup>th</sup>, fifth grade students will participate in the third administration of the STAAR Math assessment. #### Bilingual and ESL Pre-Kindergarten / Kindergarten (§89.1250)

The program is designed for students who are currently in pre-kinder and kindergarten and identified as an English Language Learner (ELL). The student must be eligible for admission to kindergarten or grade 1 the upcoming school year and the parent approved placement in the required bilingual or ESL program. Enrollment is optional and the program shall operate on the equivalent of 120 hours of instruction. The purpose of the program is for ELLs to have an opportunity to receive special instruction designed to prepare them to be successful in kindergarten and grade 1. Instruction shall focus on language development and the essential knowledge and skills appropriate for the student. Instruction will target core curriculum and performance standards mandated by the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS). Small group learning activities in reading will include an emphasis on reading for meaning and critical analysis. Likewise, students who need math support will also be engaged in small group instruction which will target each student's learning needs. On Tuesday, June 26, eighth grade students will participate in the third administration of the STAAR Math assessment. #### High School STAAR / End-of-Course Prep. Classes

GISD offers high school STAAR / EOC prep for students who need to meet the requirements of the State of Texas Assessment of Academic Readiness (STAAR) tests. Instruction will target core curriculum and performance standards as set forth in the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills, or TEKS. Instruction will focus on the EOC tests in which each student may need remediation. These courses include English/Language Arts 1, English/Language Arts 2, Algebra 1, Biology, and United States History. Scores will be released at the beginning of June. Contact your child's counselor or principal for more information. STAAR/EOC Summer exams will be the week of June 26<sup>th</sup>.

These credit recovery courses are taught using Edgenuity an online, self-paced computer program. Students are allowed to complete multiple courses, as time and class size permits. #### **High School Courses for Credit Advancement**

GISD offers high school coursework for credit advancement for students wishing to earn graduation credit(s) outside of the regular school term. Students must meet all eligibility and prerequisite requirements. Courses offered include Health, Speech (Professional Communications), Government, and Economics. Students requesting Government and/or Economics must have completed U.S. History. These credit advancement courses are taught using *Edgenuity*, an online, self-paced computer program. Students may register for either one or two courses. If two courses are selected, choose one course in the morning session and one course in the afternoon session. Upon successful completion, students will receive a numerical grade. According to GISD's High School Course Guide, grades earned during summer school will be excluded when calculating the weighted GPA and academic class rank.
