Bridges COVID School Wide Expectations

HANDWASHING

- Hand sanitizer will be available at the main entry to the campus, in classrooms, in the cafeteria and in common areas throughout the campus.
- Staff and Students will have instruction in proper hand washing techniques.
- Hand washing after community activities or work tasks, before eating and following restroom breaks is expected.

VISITORS

- All individuals entering the building must wear a face mask.
- Parents will be allowed on campus by appointment only.
- Outside GISD deliveries will not be permitted. Only essential deliveries will be allowed.
- Essential Individuals permitted on to campus must follow posted safety guidelines and campus procedures.



- Students and Staff will wash hands or use hand sanitizer prior to entering the Bistro/Cafeteria.
- Students will follow and adhere to the expectations and posted directional prompts/signs to ensure proper social distancing.
- Mealtime visitors will not be permitted.
- Meals will not be delivered to students unless medical diet restrictions cannot be met by the school provided lunch.
- If a student forgets their lunch, they will be provided a brown bag lunch from the cafeteria.
- Students will be permitted to use microwaves, but will follow a strict sanitation process after heating their lunch in a microwave.
- Assigned staff supervises students in the Bistro/cafeteria to direct students to open seats, and ensures that students maintain desired social distance.

LUNCH

Bridges COVID School wide Expectations

Arrivals and Departures

- Staff will perform temperature checks prior to a student's entry to campus.
- Students must wash hands or use hand sanitizer upon arrival.
- Staff members will be assigned to supervise students who report to multiple use areas to ensure social distance guidelines are being followed.
- Separate entrances will be utilized for car riders, bus riders, walkers and Geo riders.

Classroom and Common Areas

- Visual and verbal reminders of distancing requirements will be posted.
- Visual and verbal reminders will be in place for hand washing reminders.
- Students and Staff will wash their hands or use hand sanitizer upon entering each classroom.
- Students will follow classroom procedures regarding seating charts and classroom materials.



DISTRICT GUIDANCE

Water Foundation

Students are expected to bring their own reusable water bottle.

Technology

Students will receive tech devices from their home campus prior to Monday, August 20.

Drills and Evacuation

Georgetown ISD will continue to follow the Standard Response Protocol (SRP) and its emergency actions of Lockout, Lockdown, Evacuate and Shelter.

Nurse and CNA

We will continue collaboration with district nurses to ensure the safety of each student. We will follow district guidance.

Bathroom

Structured bathroom breaks will be in place to limit the number of students and comply with health and safety guidelines.

Proper handwashing techniques will be taught to all students and consistently reinforced.

Students and staff must wash hands or use hand sanitizer upon exiting a bathroom.

Bathroom doors will be propped open.
